

FIND your SIZE

- 1 Print the next page making sure to choose the option 'scale 100%'.
- 2 Use a ruler to check if the copy corresponds to the original dimensions of the page: the straight edge of the green stripe should be exactly 100 mm in length.
- 3 Now you have two options to discover your ring size (you can use them both to be absolutely sure!)

option A

Place one of your rings (it will be easier if you use a regular width band ring) above the circle that best fits the internal diameter of your ring.

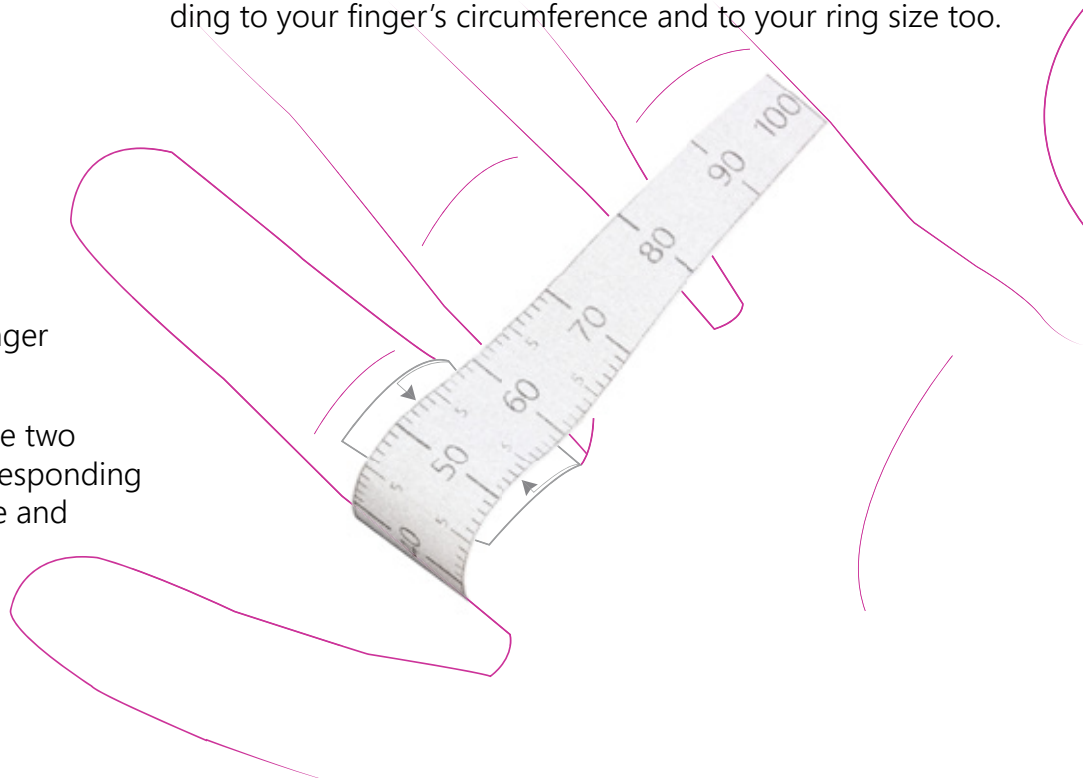
Read the number inside the circle: that's the one corresponding to your finger's circumference and to your ring size too.

option B

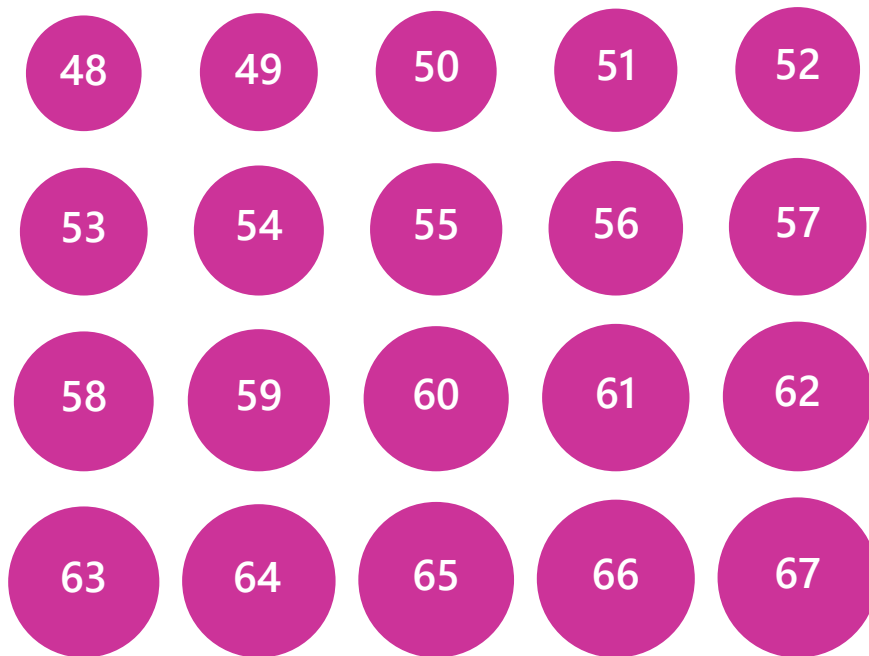
Cut out the green stripe.

Put the stripe around your finger as it is shown in the figure.

Read the number between the two indicators: that's the one corresponding to your finger's circumference and to your ring size too.
